

OUR TRAVEL'S IN THE E.T.O.
Co. "B", 13th Tank Bn.

Left Camp ~~Kilmar~~^{Polk} October 24, 1944. Arrived Camp Kilmar October 27, 1944. Left Camp Kilmar, November 5, 1944, boarded USAT "Marine Devil" at 5:00 P.M., Pier 19, Staten Island. November 7, 1944 moved into convoy formation and sailed at 1200.

Arrived South-Hampton, England, 18 November 1944, dis-embarked 1800, 19 November 1944. Arrived at Tidworth Garrison, Tidworth, England, 2200.

Left Tidworth, England, January 3, 1945 by tank to Weymouth, England. Boarded LST at Weymouth, 5 January 1945. Sailed from Weymouth 6 January 1945. Arrived Le Harve, France, 7 January 1945. Road march to Tote where we billeted in a haymow. Left Tote for Reims, 10 January 1945 and bivouaced after passing through Reims. 11 January 1945, left bivouac area, stowed tank's with ammo and headed for Lixiere, France.

Some of the town's we went through were: Verdun, Beauvaise, Pagny and Pont-A-Mussoun.

Arrived Lixiere, 13 January 1945. Left Lixiere, 23 January 1945, and arrived in Petite Hattange. 25 January 1945, moved up front, dry run. 26 January 1945, moved out to Sierk and Nennig, milk run. 27 January 1945, the battle for Sinz, Germany. 28 January 1945, withdrawal back through Nennig and Sierk to Petite Hattange where we re-organized, then moved back to Lixiere. Left Lixiere, 2245, 2 February 1945. Arrived Bende, Belgium, 1800, 3 February 1945. Chowd and re-fuelled. Moved out again and arrived in Buckholtz, Holland, 0700, 4 February 1945. Left Buckholtz, 1220, 21 February 1945, and arrived Schilburg, Holland, 1420. During march Jerry plane's strafed rear column. Left Schilburg, 1880, 26 February 1945, on march to Rhine. Crossed the Roer River at 2200, same day. In the following action we went through St. George, Boiseheim, and took Lobberich on the morning of 2 March 1945. From there we moved on to Wankum. Left Wankum, 4 March 1945, and arrived in Linfort. Left Linfort, 8 March 1945, and garrisoned in Hinsbeck. Left Hinsbeck, 2300 on 26 March 1945 and crossed the Rhine just below Wessel at 0400, 27 March 1945. Moved on into Eichelkemper, Germany. 28 March 1945, we moved into Dorsten, from there to Polsum on 30 March 1945. Moved from Polsum, 31 March 1945 and arrived in Selm, 1 April 1945. The following are a few of the town's that we took while cleaning up the Ruhr pocket. 6 April 1945, Wester and Reiden. 7 April 1945, Menzel. 8 April 1945, Werl. 9 April 1945, Neheim. On 11 April, 1945, we assisted in taking Unna. Left Unna, 12 April 1945, on a march through Werle, Souest, Padderborn and arrived in Wolfenbuttel, 14 April 1945. On 18 April 1945, we moved from Wolfenbuttel to Seehausen. Left Seehausen, 19 April 1945, past through Oschersleben, Strobeck and billeted in Wernegrode. Moved from Wernegrode to Oker, 22 April 1945. Stayed overnight then moved to Bad Harzburg, 23 April 1945, where we garrisoned. Left Bad Harzburg, 13 May 1945, and moved to Osterode. On 14 May 1945, we moved from Osterode to Clausthal-Zellerfeld where we again garrisoned. We left Clausthal-Zellerfeld, 2 June 1945, on a march to Ledce, Czechoslovakia. We passed through the following town's: Osterode, Duderstadt, Leinefelde, Dingelstadt, Muhlhausen, Langensalza, Gotha, Weimar, Hermsdorf, Bayruth, Kemnath, Erbdorf, Neustadt, Weiden, Wernberg, Vohenstraub, Haib, Wies, Pilsen and arrived in Ledce, 4 June 1945.
